#### **(b) Conditions leading to severe functional impairments**

(e.g.) compulsive disorder (OCD); Anxiety/phobic/panic disorders; Bulimia nervosa; ADHD where there is significant psychiatric co-morbidity; Autistic spectrum disorders; Tourette's syndrome; School refusal where mental health disorder plays a significant role; Conduct difficulties which co-exist with other disorders; Severe and/or complex relationship difficulties

#### **(c) Children and young people with learning disabilities experiencing emotional or behavioural or mental health difficulties**

#### **(d) Emotional difficulties relating to physical conditions (e.g. Diabetes; Asthma; Neurological conditions; Unexplained pain/ somatising disorders**

**(e) Early intervention to prevent the development of more severe disorders**  
(e.g. Complicated bereavement; Post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD); Severe attachment difficulties; Self-care issues)
